- (a) What is democracy? Explain it as a tool for social change.
- (b) Explain the meaning of an 'NGO' with an example. How do NGOs mobilize and manage their grants/funds.
- (c) Write a note on the role of a 'social activist' for social change.
- (d) Define and explain the concept of 'poverty'. How can social work as a practic intervene in its reduction.
- (e) What are evaluation and follow up? How are they relevant in training process for social administration.

- (a) Describe in detail the different types of methods with relevant examples.
- (b) Define and describe social change. What are the factors that influence social change? Give examples.
